

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Committee	MCQ Standard Setting Working Group
Initiated	April 1, 2025
Scheduled review	2027

PURPOSE

The Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) Standard Setting Working Group (committee) works collaboratively to evaluate items to ultimately set the cut score for an administration of the Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional MCQ Examination.

SCOPE/RESPONSIBILITIES

To evaluate MCQ Items that have been selected for an examination administration with the view to setting the cut score for the administration.

AUTHORITY

The decisions made by the working group are final.

MEMBERSHIP

Each Canadian province and territory may provide one to three members to the committee.

MEETINGS

Meetings are called within six weeks of the administration (before or after).

Present at the meetings is the committee (typically 8 – 9 denturists), a psychometrician, and regulator (if required).

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

Work completed by the committee is used by the psychometricians to set the cut score for the administration.



RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO COMMITTEE

- Psychometric support
- Regulatory support
- Resource material, as required

DELIVERABLES

Evaluate MCQ Items for an administration so that the administration's cut score may be determined.

REVIEW SCHEDULE

These terms of reference will be reviewed at least every five years.
