TERMS OF REFERENCE

PURPOSE

The Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) Review Committee (committee) works collaboratively to review station/item performance on an administration of a Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination and makes determination of valid items.

SCOPE/RESPONSIBILITIES

To review OSCE items for an examination administration based on item performance as determined by the psychometrician. The committee will determine which of the discussed items are valid and shall remain and contribute to candidates' overall scores and which items should be removed from the scoring of the administration of concern.

AUTHORITY

The committee's decisions are final.

MEMBERSHIP

The committee is composed of two or three experienced denturist examiners representing engaged regulators.

MEETINGS

Meetings are called approximately one month after the examination administration.

Present at the meetings are the committee and psychometrician.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

Work completed by the committee is reported to the provincial/territorial regulators.

RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO COMMITTEE

- Psychometric support
- Regulatory support
- Resource material, as required

These terms of reference will be reviewed at least every five years.
