



TERMS OF REFERENCE

Committee	OSCE Station Development Working Group
Initiated	April 1, 2025
Scheduled review	2027

PURPOSE

The Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) Station Development Working Group (committee) works collaboratively to develop OSCE stations suitable for the Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination.

SCOPE/RESPONSIBILITIES

To develop OSCE stations for the examination which are mapped to the Canadian Denturist National Competency Profile.

AUTHORITY

The stations developed are final and will be piloted and validated.

MEMBERSHIP

Each Canadian province and territory may provide one to three members to the committee.

MEETINGS

Meetings are called as required.

Present at the meetings is the committee (typically 8 – 9 denturists), a psychometrician, and regulator (if required).

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

Work completed by the committee is reported to the provincial/territorial regulators.

RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO COMMITTEE

- Psychometric support
- Regulatory support
- Resource material, as required



Valid, relevant OSCE stations mapped to the appropriate competency profile for the profession.

These terms of reference will be reviewed at least every five years.
