Remote Proctoring Candidate Agreement¹

MCQ Candidate Code of Conduct

- All candidates will abide by the Candidate Code of Conduct. Failure to do so will have an impact on their examination outcome.
- Candidates may not seek, nor offer, assistance to any other candidate during the examination period. The examination period begins at registration and continues until candidates have been dismissed from the afternoon sitting of the MCQ.
- Candidates will not engage in any disruptive behaviour during the examination period.
- Candidates will not harass any other candidate, proctor, or other staff. A candidate guilty of this may be found to have forfeited the examination opportunity.
- Candidates will not, under any circumstances, contact a proctor prior to or after an examination.
- Candidates will not take photographs and/or videography of the examination. This is strictly prohibited and will result in the termination of the examination attempt, as well as a failing grade.
- Candidates will follow direction provided by examination staff during the examination period.
- Aside from the technology required to complete the examination, no electronic devices, are permitted during the examination with the exception of necessary medical devices that have been identified and pre-approved.

Candidate Responsibilities

I understand, acknowledge, and agree that I am solely responsible for:

- a. having reviewed the technical and environmental requirements for writing the examination online and to ensure I meet the technical and environmental requirements in advance of the start of the examination;
- b. the access to and functionality of my technical equipment, including but not limited to my internet connection, and that failure of any technical equipment or to meet the technical requirements during the examination could result in my exam being invalidated.

Technical issues that are not a result of the proctoring service provider's system will not constitute grounds for appeal of any examination results; and

- c. my testing environment during the examination and that any issues in the testing environment are my responsibility and will not constitute grounds for any appeal of the examination results.

Confidentiality and Copyright

I understand, acknowledge, and agree that:

- a. all examination materials and examination-related information, including, but not limited to, the examination itself are confidential, and that the partner Colleges maintain and contractually require strict confidentiality and security thereof. Stringent protocols and security measures have been put into place to ensure that the integrity of all examinations and the examination content is always maintained. These measures are designed to eliminate any unfair advantage among candidates and avoid the high cost of replacing the examination content in the event of a security breach; and
- b. to preserve the confidentiality and security of the examination, I am strictly prohibited, at all times, from disclosing to any person or organization, reproducing by any means (whether recorded from memorization, by electronic device, or by any other means), and displaying or publishing any examination content or any of the other examination materials or examination-related information whatsoever (whether for commercial or non-commercial purposes). Such content includes but is not limited to topics, items, questions, scenarios, fact patterns, cases, correct answers, and incorrect answers, from an examination. Any disclosure contrary to this section would be a breach of my covenant of confidentiality.

Prohibited Conduct

I shall not engage in any form of dishonesty, fraud, cheating, misrepresentation, or other misconduct related to the examination, including, but not limited to:

- a. consulting an unauthorized source during the examination;
- b. bringing any unauthorized materials into my testing environment;

- c. removing from the examination area any unauthorized materials, including but not limited to notes taken from the examination;
- d. being in possession of or using unauthorized information or materials prior to or during an examination; and
- e. assisting a person to carry out any of these activities, including failing to report information known about another candidate's breach of their obligations to the Colleges regarding the examination, any obligation specific to the Candidate Agreement or other obligations to the Colleges.

Privacy

I further understand, acknowledge, and agree that:

- a. information related to every candidate will be disclosed to the proctoring service provider, MonitorEDU, including each eligible candidate name, email address, candidate number, the name of the examination for which the candidate is eligible, and any accommodations provided for completing the examination;
- b. to provide their services, MonitorEDU also requires from each candidate their name, cell phone number, email address, IP address, the name of the examination the candidate is writing, and indication of the testing organization(s);
- c. information required by MonitorEDU to provide their services will be temporarily stored in the United States of America (USA) as MonitorEDU is based in the USA. I have reviewed and agree to MonitorEDU's privacy policy <https://monitoredu.com/your-privacy>.
- d. during the examination, "live" video streams from my computer's webcam and secondary camera are being reviewed, in real-time, by remote examination proctors and consent to same. During the examination, I agree to abide by any reasonable requests made by the proctor to help ensure the integrity of the examination process. The proctor may request that I show multiple angle views of myself and the immediate environment. I may also be asked to adjust the cameras, seating position, or objects within the testing environment. Failure to abide by the proctor's instructions may result in my examination session being flagged for further review or terminated and/or my examination results invalidated;
- e. the video streams may be recorded, and I hereby irrevocably consent to the recording and the storage of the recording. In the event the proctor perceives, in the proctor's sole determination, any attempts at cheating or other irregular testing behaviour, segments of my testing experience may be recorded and stored for the Colleges' review and records without further notice to me and without my further consent or approval. I confirm that I have no right to review or receive a copy of any such recording; and
- f. the proctor and/or the Colleges will have the ability to conduct key stroke tracking and use artificial intelligence to track my eye movement and other conditions in the room only for the purposes of maintaining examination security, and only for the duration of the examination. I consent to the use of such technology during the examination.

Acknowledgements

- I acknowledge that I have read this agreement and fully understand its content.
- I understand that should I be found in breach of the MCQ Candidate Code of Conduct or any other examination rule, I forfeit the examination attempt and may be reported to professional and/or legal authorities, and/or held responsible for damages and cost-recovery.
- I understand that I must declare any hinderance or disability adversely affecting my examination performance prior to leaving the examination site.
- I will not depart the examination centre until I am dismissed by examination staff.
- I understand that candidates must sign this declaration. Refusing to do so jeopardizes my participation in the examination process.
